## EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The graduate exit survey is designed to solicit student feedback for institutional effectiveness and strategic planning purposes. Comprehensive institutional effectiveness assessment includes both curricular (educational services) and co-curricular (support services). The questions/statements on the survey were intentionally designed to address student perceptions, expectations, experience, and satisfaction with regard to Institutional Learning Outcomes (ILOs), Program Learning Outcomes (PLOs), faculty, staff, student life experience, technology, safety & security, facilities and maintenance, library services, financial services, institutional loyalty, and graduate placement/employability. Thus, both the educational services and support services of the College are addressed and assessed through this survey.

Survey questions were listed in the form of a positive statement with a corresponding Likert scale from 1-7, with 1 being "Completely Disagree" and 7 being "Completely Agree."

Highlighting: **Green** = Positive/Promote; **Yellow** = Neutral/Caution; **Red** = Alert/Needs Attention.

### Key Observations

1. **Statement #1** (pg. 4): "BBC offers a **spiritual climate** that helps students **grow and develop in their walk with God.**" Responses were overwhelmingly positive: 45 of 51 students (88.24%) reported a score of 5-7. Only 3 students (5.88%) reported a score lower than 4.
2. **Statement #2** (pg. 4): "While I know that I still have more to learn, BBC's overall **Bible training** has met my expectations." Responses were positive: 36 of 51 students (70.59%) reported a score of 5-7. Only 7 students (13.73%) reported a score lower than 4.
3. **Statement #3** (pg. 5): "While I recognize that college is a big investment, I believe **BBC's cost is a good value** in comparison to other colleges." Responses were generally positive: 33 of 51 students (64.71%) reported a score of 5-7. However, 8 students (15.69%) reported a score of 4, and 10 students (19.61%) reported a score of 1-3.
4. **Statement #4** (pg. 5): "If I had it to do all over again, **I would choose to attend college at BBC.**" Responses were generally positive: 34 of 51 students (66.67%) reported a score of 5-7. However, 6 students (11.76%) reported a score of 4, and 11 students (21.57%) reported a score of 1-3 with 4 students reporting a score of 1.
5. **Statement #5** (pg. 6): "If I had it to do all over again, **I would pursue the same major.**" Responses were overwhelmingly positive: 44 of 51 students (86.27%) reported a score of 5-7. Only 2 students (3.92%) reported a score lower than 4.
6. **Statement #6** (pg. 6): "While I know that I still have more to learn, I believe **my program has adequately prepared me to enter my field of study.**" Responses were overwhelmingly positive: 44 of 51 students (86.27%) reported a score of 5-7. Only 6 students (11.76%) reported a score lower than 4.
7. **Statement #13** (pg. 10): "As a graduate, I feel a **strong personal connection to BBC.**" Responses were positive: 39 of 51 students (76.47%) reported a score of 5-7. However, 11 students (21.57%) reported a score lower than 4, with 5 students reporting a score of 1.

8. **Statement #16** (pg. 11): “BBC’s **library staff and resources** have generally met my expectations.” Responses were overwhelmingly positive: 47 of 51 students (92.16%) reported a score of 5-7. Only 1 student (1.96%) reported a score lower than 4.  
**NOTE:** This statement received the highest number of 5-7 ratings on the survey.
9. **Statement #18** (pg. 12): “BBC offers a **safe and secure campus.**” Responses were proportionately disbursed and low. Only 24 of 51 students (47.06%) reported a score of 5-7. 7 students (13.73%) reported a score of 4, and 20 students (39.22%) reported a score of 1-3.  
**NOTE:** This statement received the lowest ratings on the survey.
10. **Statements #21 and #22** (pgs. 14-15): “In what regular **local church ministries** have you served while attending BBC?” What ministries do you anticipate for the **future?** Student responses indicate significant involvement and service in numerous local church ministries.
11. **Statement #23** (pg. 15): Student responses regarding **graduate placement/employability and continuing education** indicate that 43 of 51 students (84.31%) plan to begin or continue working in their field of study and/or continue their education within the near future (0-18 months).

### **Summary**

The overall results of the graduate exit survey are **very positive** and indicate that the College is effective with regard to its Mission and the established ILOs. Students overwhelmingly affirm that BBC provides excellent Bible training (HEAD), offers a spiritual climate that helps students grow and develop in their walk with God (HEART), adequately prepares students to enter their field of study (HEAD, HAND), and facilitates/encourages students to serve/minister in the local church (HEART, HAND).

### **Action Items**

While overwhelmingly positive, the survey responses highlighted some areas for potential review and/or improvement including: safety and security enhancements, alumni loyalty development, communication enhancements, and education cost comparison for marketing and education purposes.

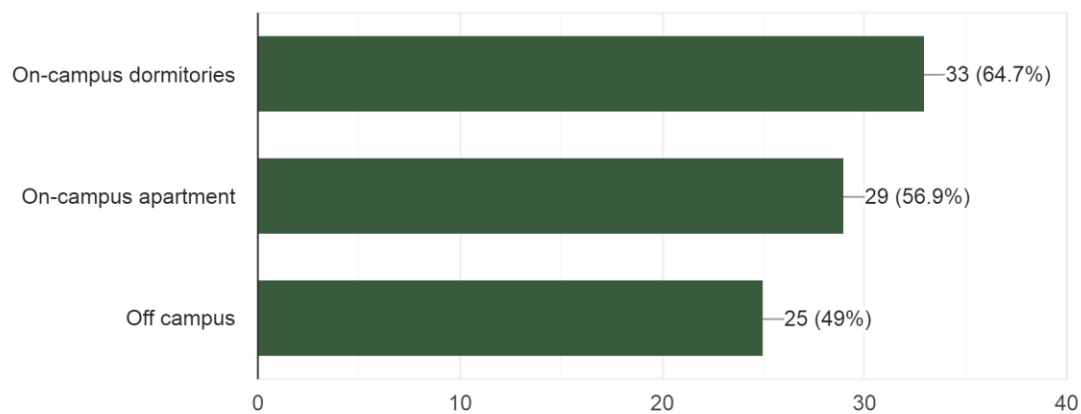

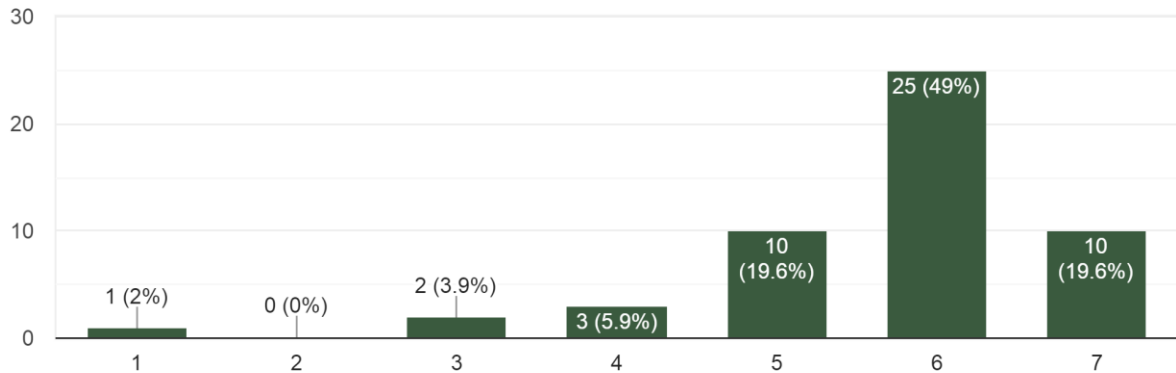

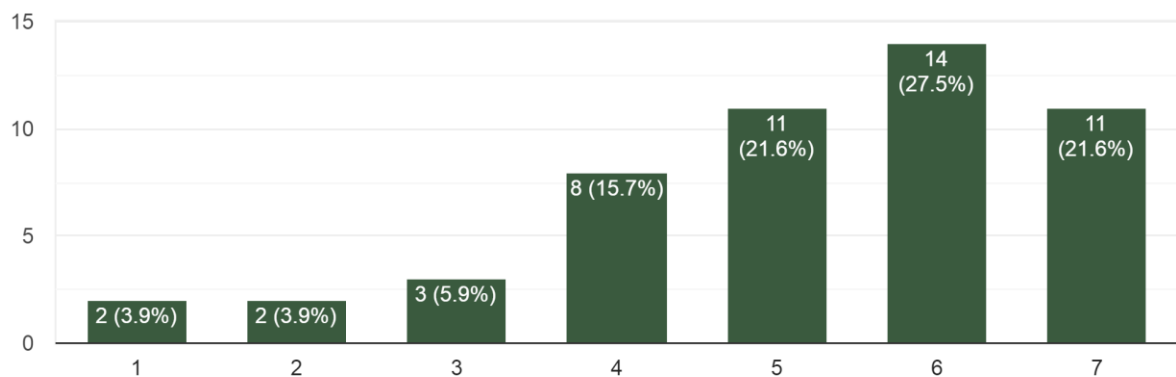

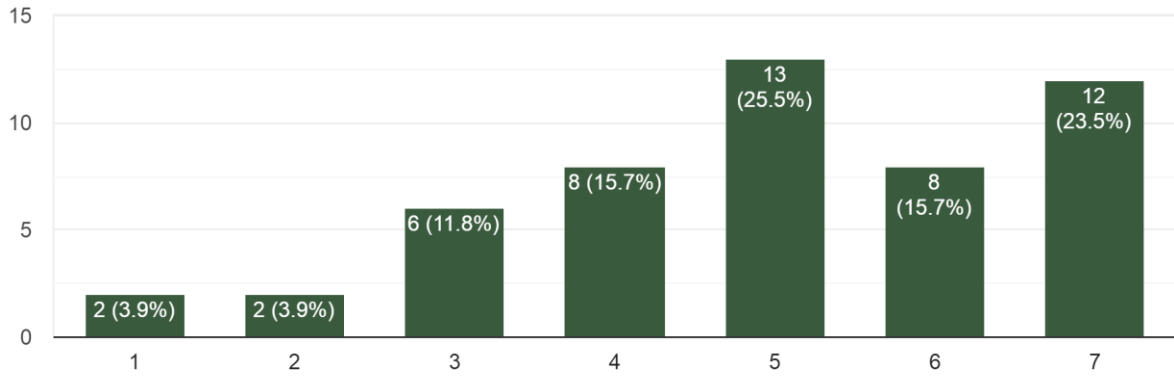

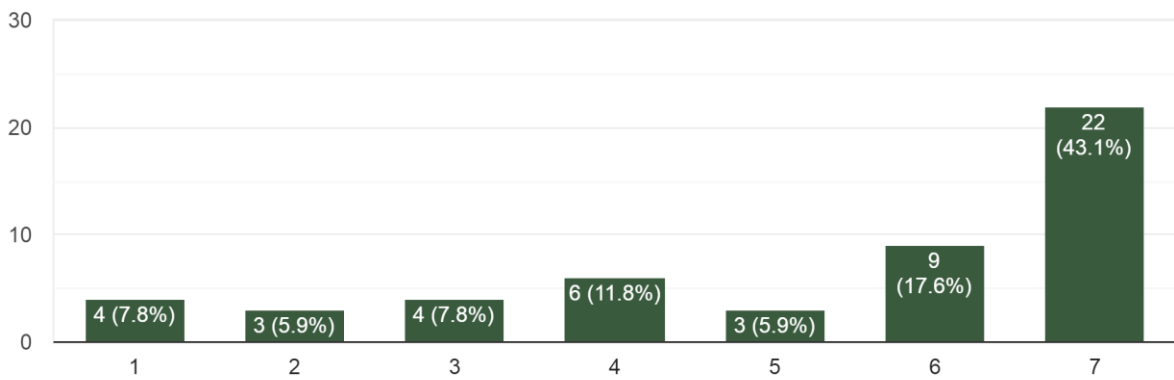

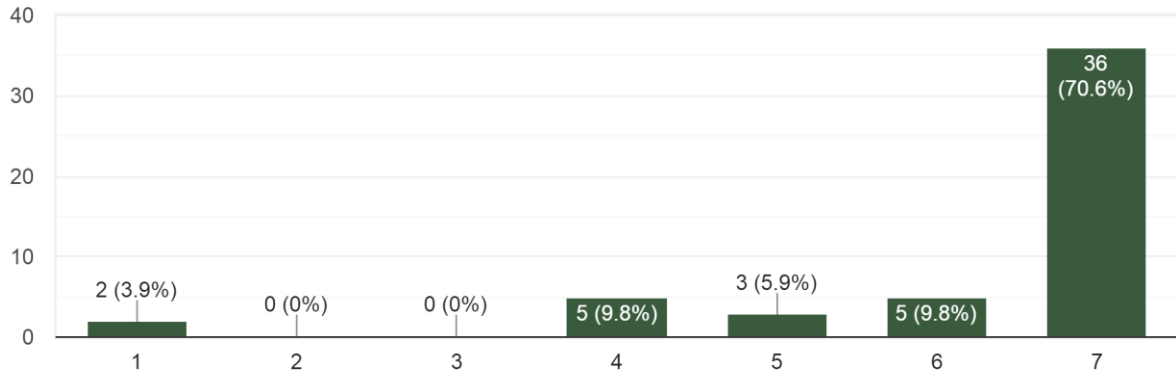

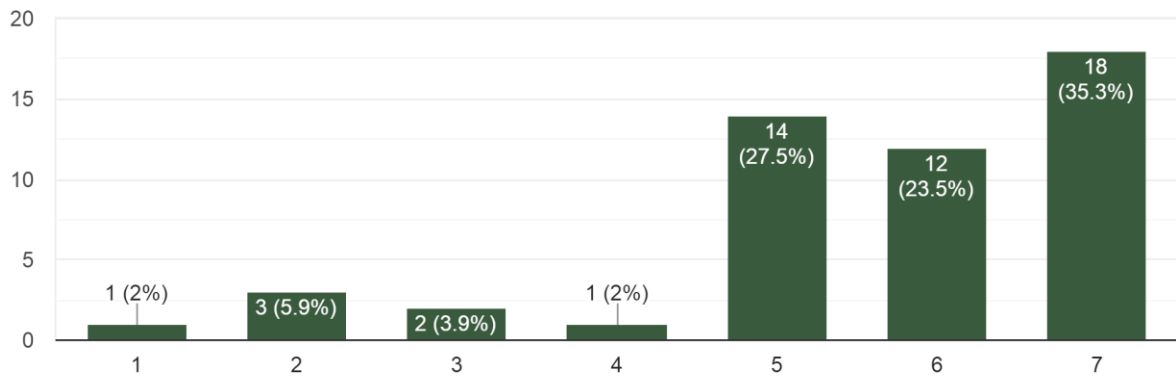

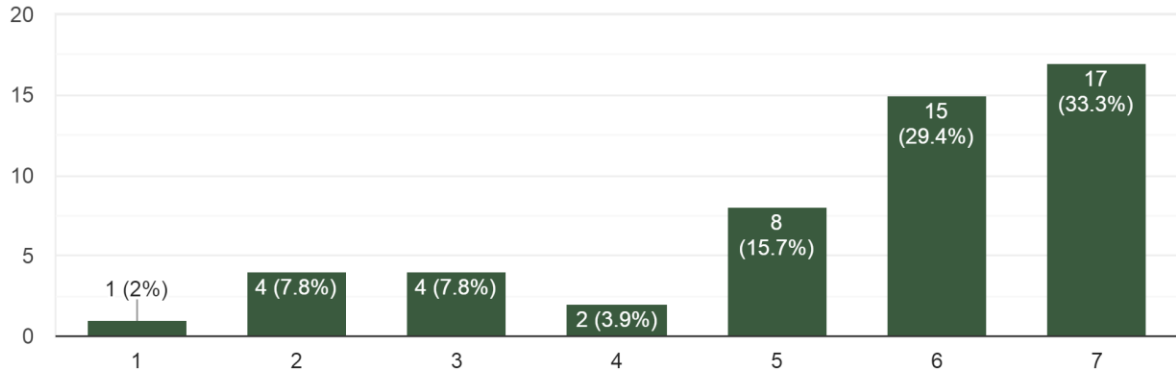

As it currently stands, the training offered within my program includes an adequate variety and number of practical experiences.

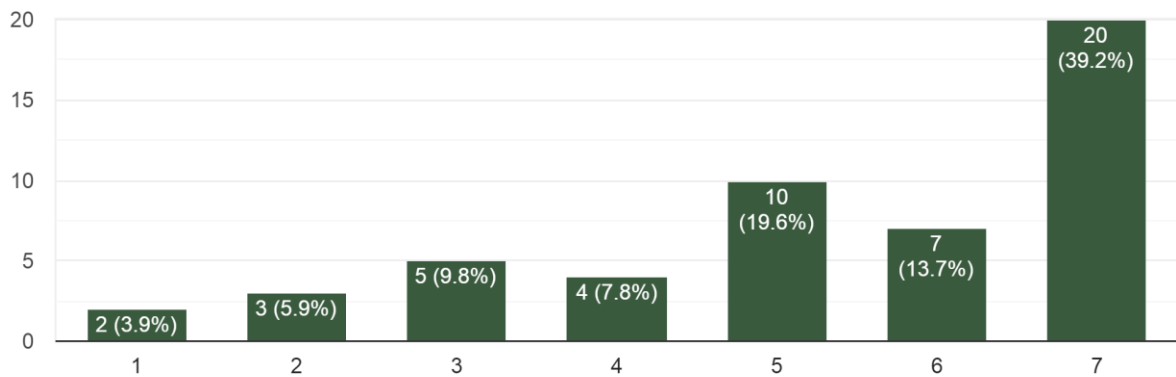

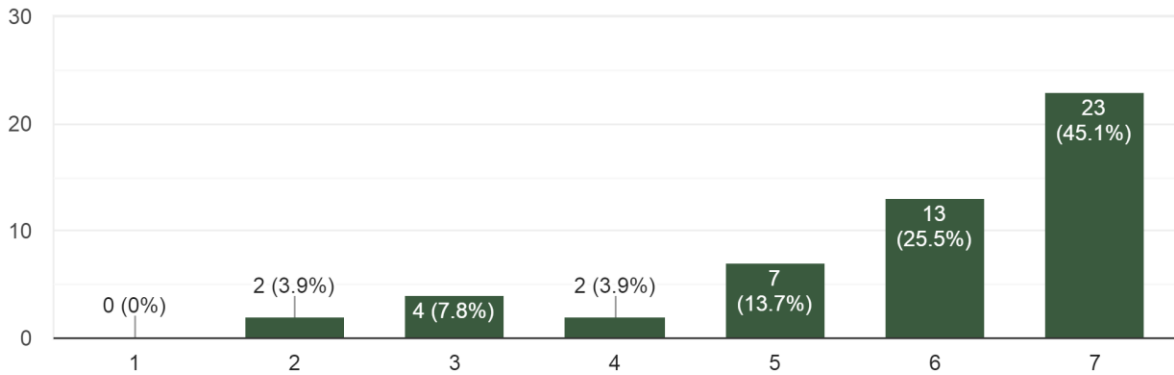

Generally speaking, my experiences with the faculty members that currently teach in my program have met my expectations.

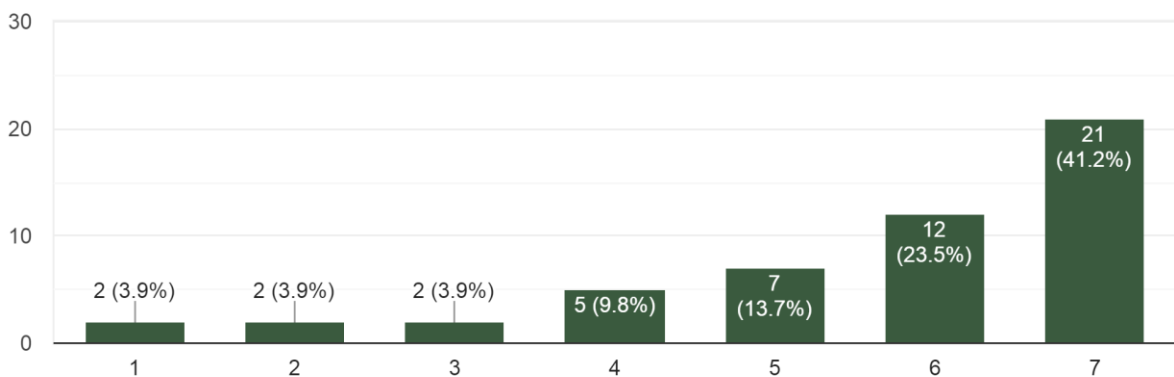

Over the past 12 months, experiences with BBC faculty members that teach outside my program have met my expectations.

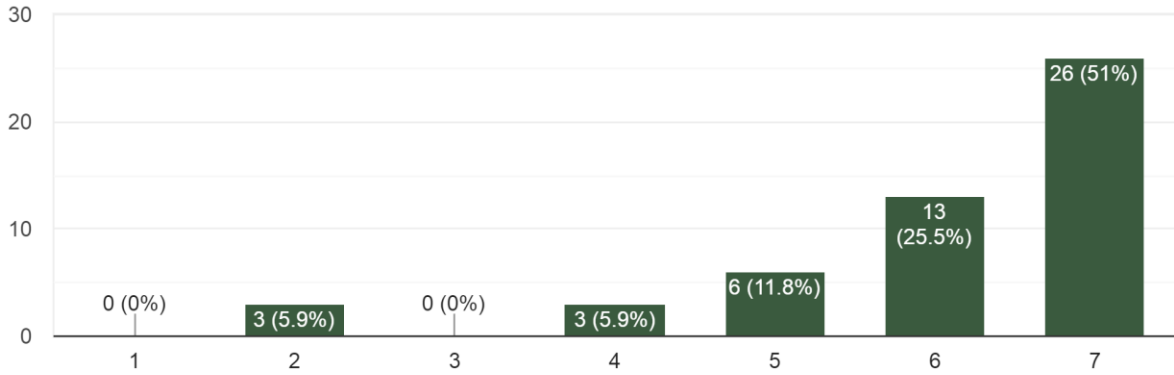

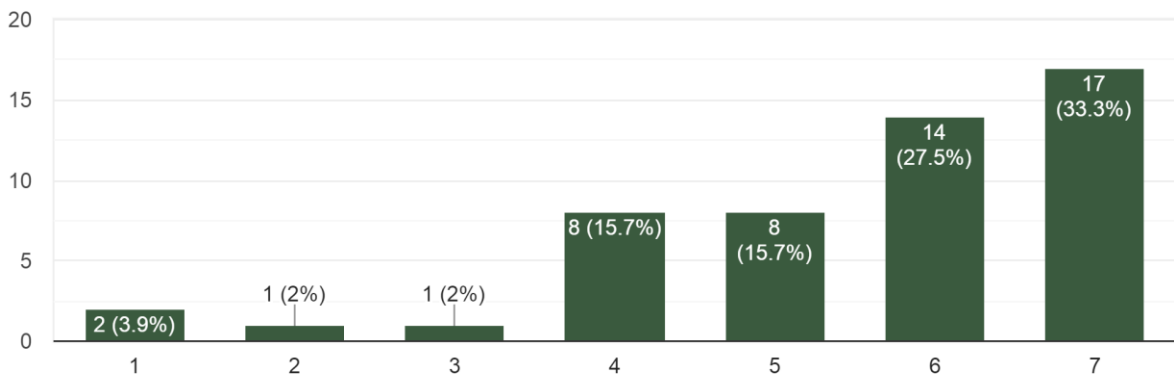

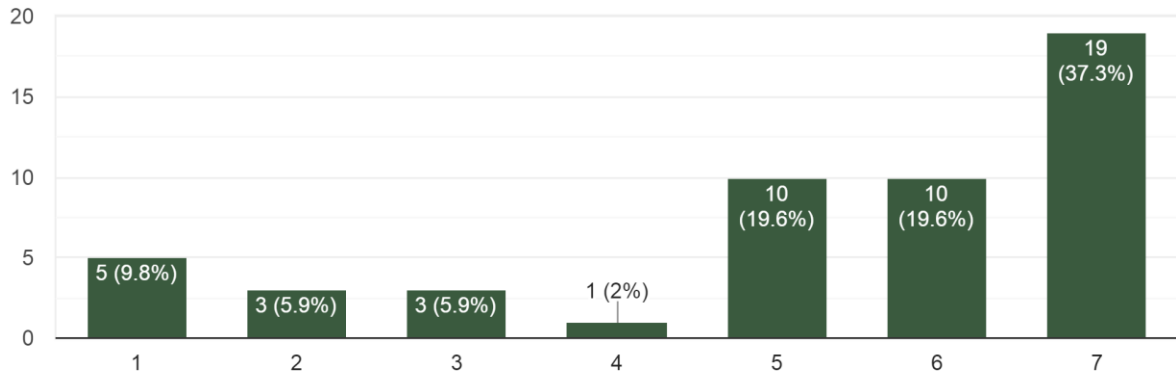

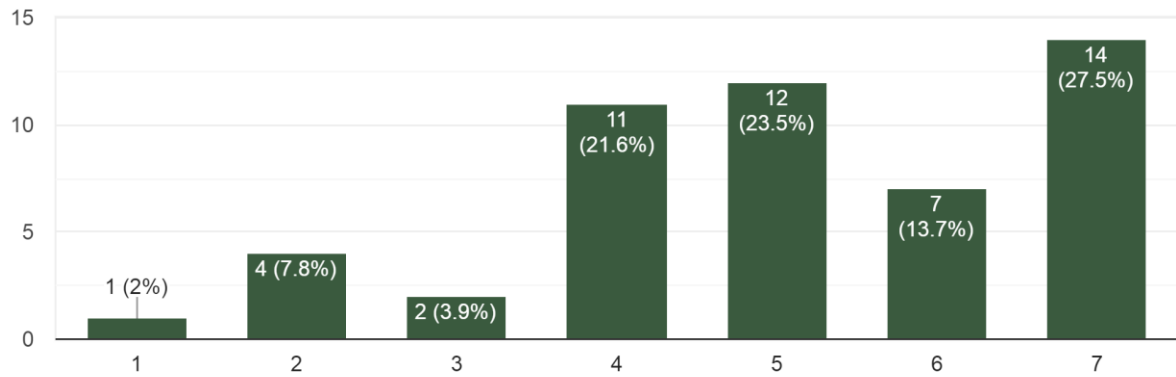

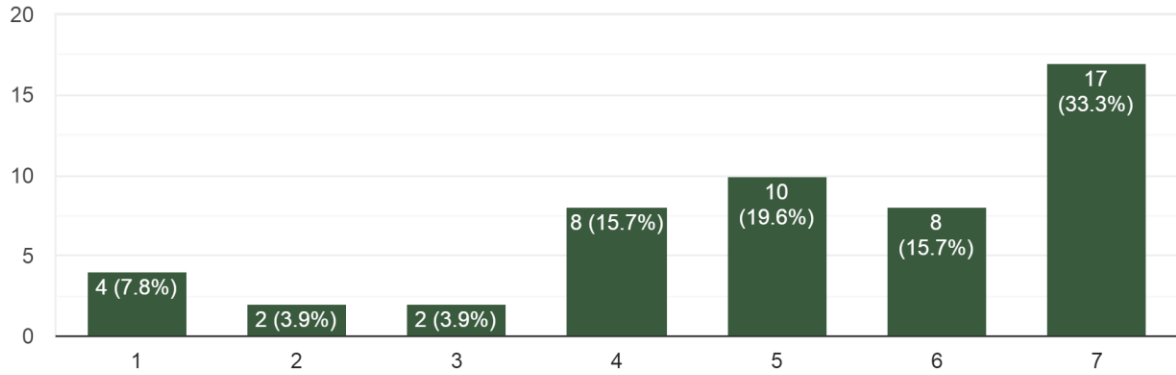

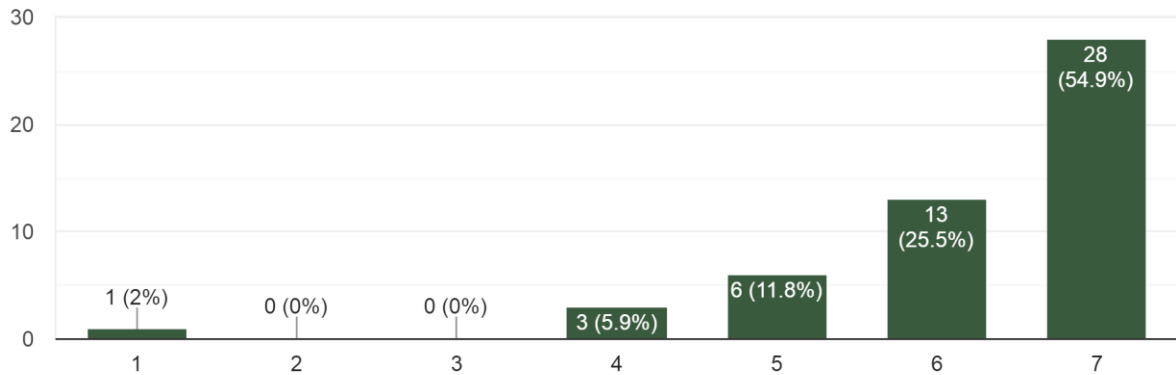

BBC's library staff and resources have generally met my expectations.

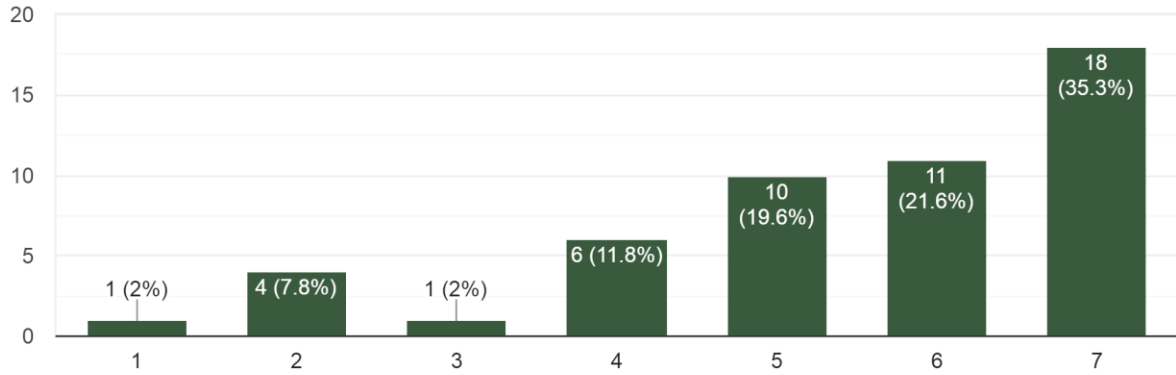

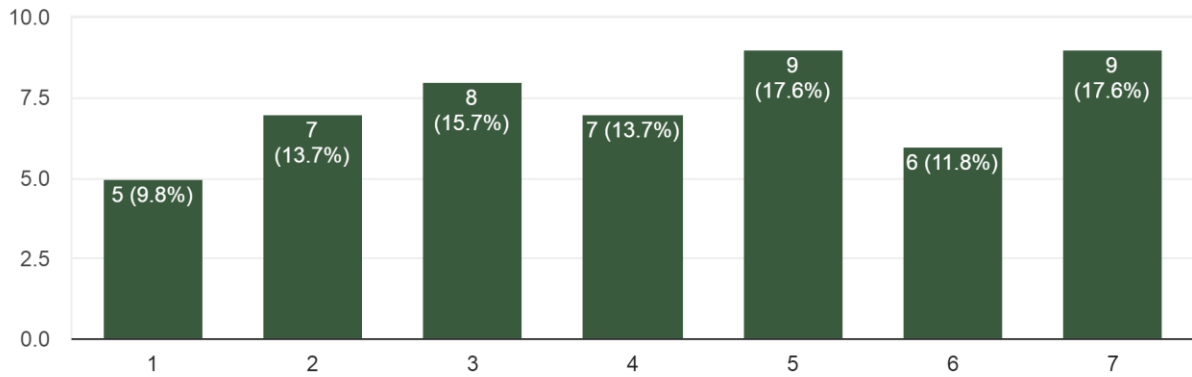

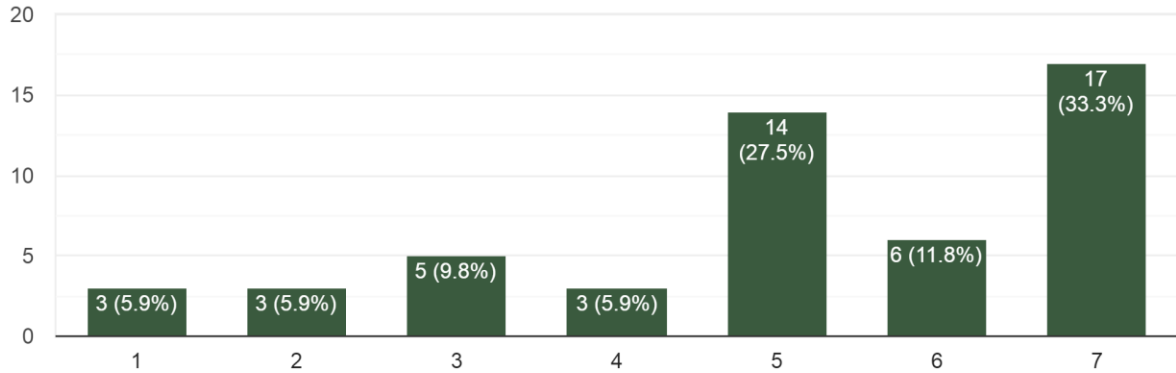

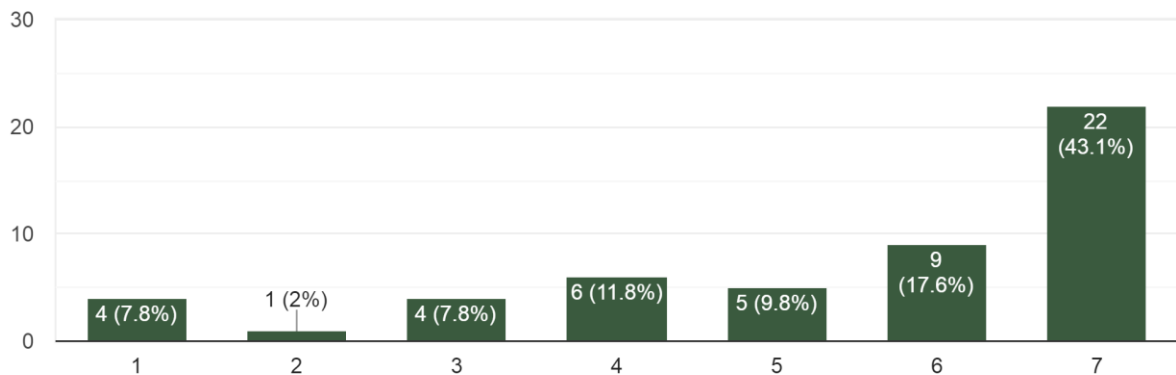

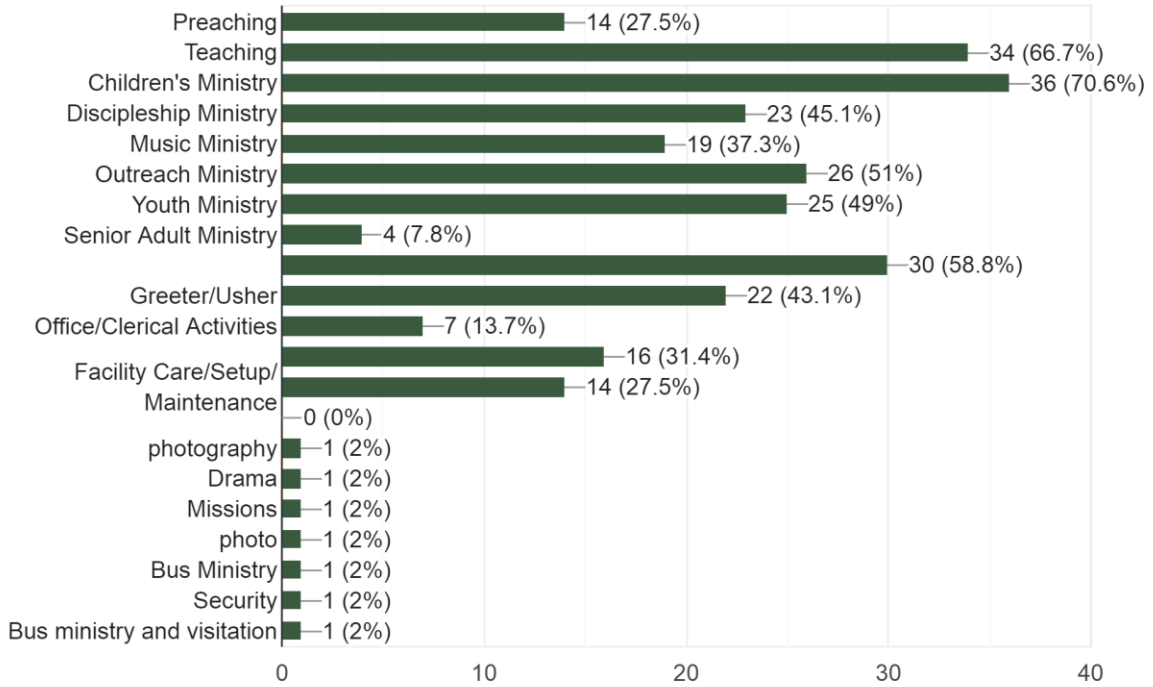

In what regular local church ministries have you served while attending BBC? Identify any pattern of service th... as a BBC student. Mark all that apply.

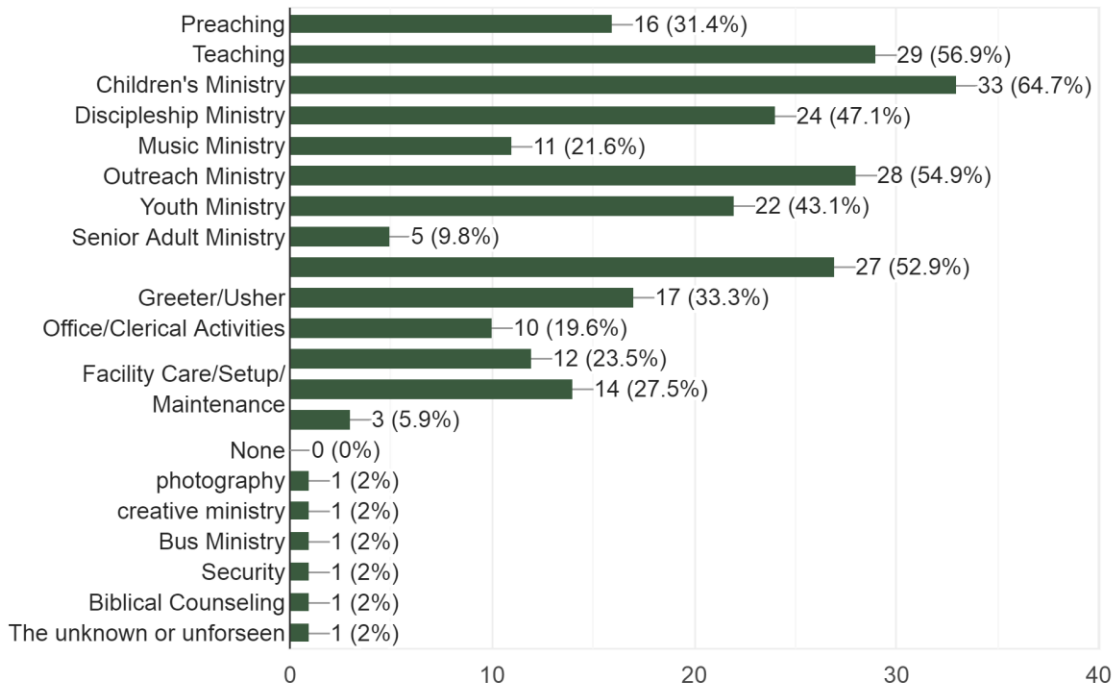

In the near future (0-18 months), what regular local church ministries do you anticipate for yourself? Select the area... after graduation. Mark all that apply.

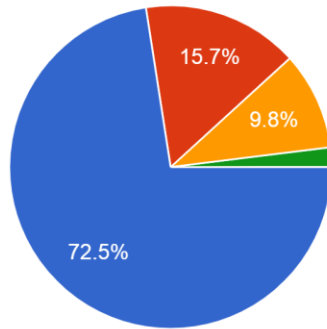

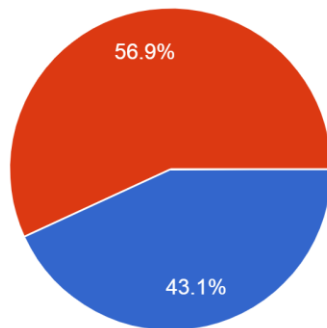
